LOCATION OF INCIDENT/CRIME

Blue Ridge Road Bikeway / HWY 113 Overpass

SUMMARY OF CRIME/INCIDENT

On 08/28/2022, at approximately 1500 hours, witnesses reported seeing 3-4 subjects standing on the bike-path overpass at HWY 113. The subjects hung signs facing vehicle traffic stating:

- "HOLOCAUST IS ANTI WHITE LIES" and
- "COMMUNISM IS JEWISH"

One of the witnesses confronted the subjects and tried to remove signs, and a verbal argument ensued but no injuries were reported. The subjects were filming encounters with counter-protesters and law enforcement and may have been trying to illicit responses. They took down the signs and left on foot, later displaying their signs on the Russell Blvd overpass according to Davis PD.

Suspect: Four white male adults, wearing all black clothing and black masks.

Vehicle: Subjects last seen on foot, headed into City of Davis through West Village

Although this did not rise to the level of a hate crime, our department has determined this to be a hate incident of concern for our campus community. Please be on the lookout for similar incidents or escalating behaviors and report to our department. For your safety, please keep your distance and do not personally intervene.

CAMPUS COMMUNITY SAFETY TIPS FROM UC DAVIS POLICE

- Always be alert to your surroundings.
- Be aware of location and situation that will make you vulnerable to crime, such as alley and dark parking lots.
- Avoid people and situations that make you nervous – trust your instincts!
- Stay in well-lighted areas as much as possible.
- Walk close to the curb and avoid doorways, bushes and alleys where someone could hide.
- Walk confidently and at a steady pace, making eye contact with people when walking.
- Use UC Davis Police Safe Rides after hours on campus by calling 530-754-COPS or download our free smart phone application (TAPRIDE)
- If you ever feel you or others are in danger, call 9-1-1.
